



### Cortona wedding planner

<b>Ceremonies</b>	Only Civil weddings in Cortona.
<b>Where</b>	In the Council hall, one of the most ancient and evocative halls of the Town Hall, located in the Piazza della Repubblica, the very heart of Cortona; other options are now available (see below).
<b>When</b>	From Monday to Sunday.
<b>How Many</b>	Up to 80 guests standing.
<b>Setting</b>	A large precious hall decorated with frescoes, a wooden inlaid and painted ceiling and historical wooden artifacts.
<b>Music</b>	Classic music.
<b>Best Period</b>	From April to October
<b>Cheap and Chic Advice</b>	If you have read "under the Tuscan sun" by Francis Mayes you don't need any advice!

Celebrate a memorable Cortona wedding! This Etruscan and Roman town with still intact Medieval city walls is a perfect backdrop for couples looking for an environment full of ancient history, art, culture and a traditional Tuscan landscape which still remembers many Tuscan Renaissance paintings.

The urban structure of the old town, with a classic Medieval stamp, includes an ancient architectural stratification which makes it a perfect set for a fabulous photo shooting, thanks to the variety of scenarios to be proposed (squares, alleys, arcades, stairways, etc. ..).

Civil weddings in Cortona are celebrated in the Council hall located in the Palazzo Comunale built in the XII century on the ruins of the ancient Roman Forum.

Since recently, though, a few more venues are available for civil weddings: the Mayor's hall, Palazzo Casali's library hall, the Medicean Fortress and the monastic complex of St. Augustine.
