Cheap and Chic Advice	Caracalla church is the biggest Rome wedding hall; if you have many guests (i.e. more than 60) choose this suggestive venue.

A very special backdrop for your wedding in Rome is a Santa Maria in Tempulo wedding; formerly a Church in an old monastery surrounded by a park, it is also known as "Caracalla Wedding Hall' due to the fact that it is located in the ruins of the Caracalla's Baths, the impressive thermal bath built in 206 aD and used until the 6th century when the Goths destroyed the aqueducts. The baths contained art galleries, gymnasia, meeting halls, gardens, libraries and shops. Throughout the complex statues and mosaics richly decorated the complex.

The interior of the marriage hall is very spacious and suggestive, with golden chairs with red cloth, high ceilings supported by wooden beams, Roman walls and marble statues.
